## Curriculum

**Stream D:** English (Core), , Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Economics and PE as an additional subject

**Stream E:** English (Core), Marketing, Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Economics and PE as an additional subject.

### Commerce Stream

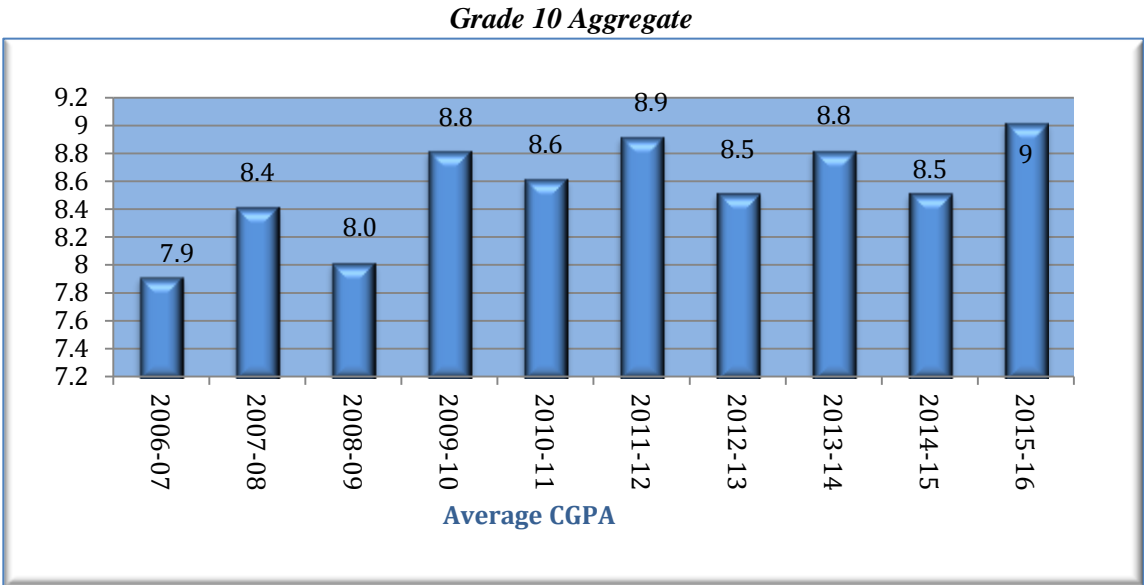
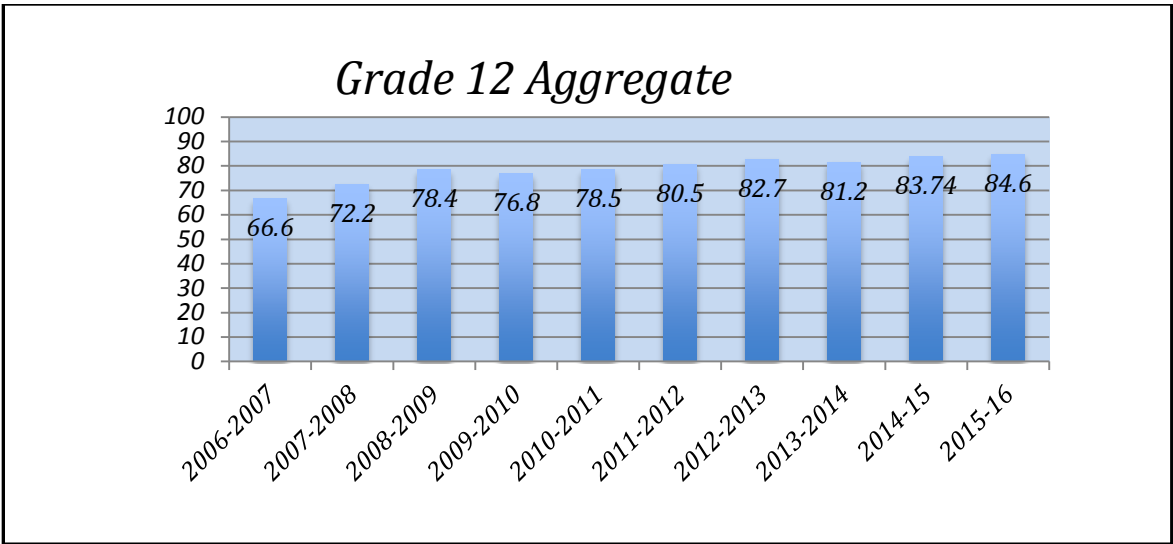

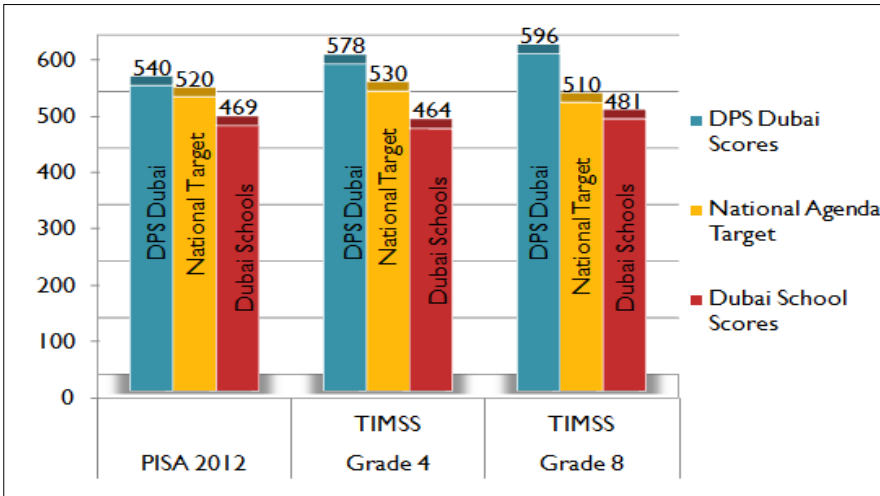
